## JANET WALSH - Painting Still life \&Florals

MATERIALS (suggested)
Watercolor Paper: Does not need to be top of the line.
l'd suggest 140\# cold press. (perhaps even watercolor tablets that artists could rip out a page to work on or a watercolor sketchbook)
Sketch Book - ( suggest Aquabee, these are great for watercolors) and a supply of \# 2 pencils, pencil sharpener and kneaded rubber erasers
Painting board - Gaterboard is excellent, use either support clips or artist tape to secure your paper
Easel, Whatever you use, or cardboard supports
Water containers, natural sponges, tissues, tracing paper, paper towels and a small spray bottle to rewet your paints,
Palette, I use an old John Pike Brushes - \#8, or \#10 Round 1/2"or 3/4" Flat \# 4 Liner, for fine lines
Paints - These are my current colors

## GREENS

Skips Green AJ
Viridian Green AJ A small tube of Designer White Gouache
( DS - Daniel Smith ) (AJ - American Journey ) ( WN - Winsor Newton )
I paint upright most of the time. If you have not tried to paint this way before you might want to experiment.
